The competition promoter is the Instructional Leadership Programme. The competition is open to students attending schools in the Republic of Ireland on Monday, 30th April 2018. Individual and group entries (max of four) are allowed. Posters should be size A3. By entering the competition, entrants agree to be bound by the rules. An independent panel of judges will be selected to judge the entries. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into. No cash alternatives will be given in exchange for any prizes. Entries will not be returned. Entries must be received by the ETBI, Piper's Hill, Kilcullen Road, Naas, Co. Kildare no later than **4pm on Monday 30th April 2018**. Schools may submit multiple entries. Each entry should have its own completed entry form.

Entries can be submitted in Irish or in English.

All entries must include, in legible writing on the back of the artwork, the following details: the name of entrant(s), school year(s) of entrant(s), name of teacher, name of the school, contact address or email of school.

Only finalists and the winners will be notified directly through their schools and this will be done on Friday, 11th May 2018. Winners will also be announced on our website: www.instructionalleadership.ie

One-for-all gift vouchers valued at €200 will be awarded for the winning entry and €100 for the runner-up.

The school of the winning entry will receive a prize of a framed version of the winning poster.
